Students will gain greater access to quality books through school libraries by schools joining the Delaware Libraries Consortium broadening students' access to **over 4 million items!**

How does it work?

- **Participating local school libraries** are integrated into the library consortium catalog software.
- **The DLC Team** from the Delaware Division of Libraries manages the migration and provides training for local school librarians on the library software.
- **Sharing books** with other Delaware Libraries occurs later in the process, when the local school librarian can manage it. A delivery system moves books among the libraries. Local librarians ensure that books are age appropriate for the students that they serve.

Additional Benefits of DLC Membership:

- **Library Collaboration**– school libraries have access to new technologies as they evolve and the shared expertise of library professionals across the state
- **Library Support**– school libraries have support from a dedicated team of library catalog System Administrators with decades of experience.
- **Library Shared Collections**– students have potential access to more titles and collections beyond those in the local library, and are experiencing the same system as they move between libraries in the community and across the state.
- **Library Power** – together, the Delaware Library Consortium forms a single unified voice for change and support of school libraries, and all libraries.
